Thanks to the likes of Scenic Eclipse, the world's first discovery yacht, you can now see the wonders of this wilderness in extreme opulence and style.

Many Arctic yacht cruises disembark on the east coast of the USA or Canada; enjoy the opportunity to explore New England after your intense exploration of the frozen north. Alternatively, discover the Russian Arctic on an ultimate adventure like no other.

On a yacht cruise adventure, expect to be blown away by the sight of crested ibises, sea lions, kittiwakes, auklets, puffins, and orca whales. Other yacht cruises remain in the Far East and Southeast Asia. Journey from Bangkok to Bali, or Hong Kong to the lesser-known islands of Japan and South Korea. Witness stunning skylines and vibrant cities, learn of historic triumphs and tragedies, marvel at the beauty of nature, and be immersed in exotic and intriguing cultures.

Take a Grand Voyage that will lead you from the tango beats of Rio de Janeiro all the way to the capital of Portugal with plenty of stops along the way. Enjoy the voyage in style, elegance, and luxury on board a yacht cruise. 
On Santo Antão Island, taste the famous Cape Verde rum or 'grogue' as it is commonly known. Climb to the top of Topo de Coroa and be rewarded with stunning panoramic views. Tenerife and Madeira are common ports of call on yacht cruises, offering a slice of sun a little closer to home.



Sail into the sunset and explore vast and varied landscapes aboard yacht cruises to Iberia, Western Europe, the wilderness of the Scottish Highlands and Hebridean Islands, or venture deep into Scandinavia on the ultimate Viking voyage.

Yacht cruises are guaranteed to show you a side to Northern Europe that you perhaps didn't know existed. Enjoy colourful quaysides and authentic boats in Douarnenez and walk the Normandy beaches of the D-Day landings from Cherbourg. Yacht cruises in Northern Europe will open your eyes to places closer to home that are well worth a visit.



Rather like the Indian Ocean, the Pacific is a region studded with beautiful islands and is therefore perfect for yacht cruises. There are diverse cultures mingling together and different archipelagos all with an identity uniquely their own. Indulging in a yacht-style cruise can be one of the more adventurous ways to tour the Pacific as you will have access to smaller ports and more remote locations. Itineraries which include the Pacific are oftentimes longer in duration and more intensive with their excursions, due to the islands being nestled far away. Enjoy the opportunity to see Kitava, a small and unspoilt island within the Trobiand Islands in the Solomon Sea. Visit the Louisiade Archipelago which is a string of ten larger volcanic islands and 90 smaller coral islands in Papua New Guinea. The Samarai Islands are part of the Louisiade Archipelago and are fantastic for snorkelling as well as being home to one of the world's oldest-surviving buildings. Suffice it to say that the Pacific is one of the most untouched and remote regions to travel to, and if you are a lover of idyllic tropical islands and tranquil paradise, then small-ship yacht cruises are the way forward.



If you are unfamiliar with the cruise world, the term 'repositioning' might seem a strange one. The different climates around the world mean that ships tend to spend the summer season in one region before moving to another to take advantage of the warmer climes. So, at certain points in the year, you will find somewhat more unusual itineraries where the ships move from one location to the next in their 'repositioning' cruise. Yacht cruises are no different and you can see diverse parts of the world all in the same itinerary. Consider, for example, Crystal Cruises, where you could start your journey in stunning Muscat and explore Oman's treasures. 




